182 Questions and comments from residents

There were no questions or comments.

183 Apologies for absence

The Committee received apologies for absence from Cllr Wastell (personal) and **RESOLVED** to accept the reason for absence.

The absence of Cllr Jackson was noted.

184 Declarations of Interest

Cllr Kynaston declared a pecuniary interest in item 186 by virtue of being related to the contractor appointed for the repair of the St Thomas' Church bench.

185 Jubilee event funding

- a **RESOLVED** to provide a donation of £500 to Parkgate & Neston United Reformed Church towards the cost of creating a Community Jubilee Garden.
- b **RESOLVED** to provide a donation of £200 to Neston Flower Society towards the cost of a Jubilee afternoon tea for Neston Flower Society members and friends.
- c It was noted that receipts to the value of £317.29 had been received from Ness Neighbours in respect of the donation provided by Neston Town Council (minute 160e, 12.04.22) for the Ness Neighbours Jubilee Coffee Morning.

RESOLVED to allow Ness Neighbours to use the underspend from their £500 Jubilee donation for the purchase of trees and associated costs as part of The Queen's Green Canopy (tree planting to take place in September).

- d **RESOLVED** to provide delegated authority to the Governance & Operations Manager (or Council Manager in the G&O Manager's absence) in liaison with the C&E Chair to approve requests for Jubilee event funding from EMR 339 to a maximum value of £300 per request. Delegation to end on 31 May 2022.

Cllr Kynaston temporarily left the meeting.

186 Bench repair

- a **RESOLVED** to provide delegated authority to the Governance & Operations Manager to arrange repair of the Town Council bench located in the grounds of St Mary's & St Helen's Church at a maximum cost of £300+VAT.
- b **RESOLVED** that the contractor appointed for the repair of the St Thomas' Church bench be appointed for this project to ensure a uniform outcome.

187 Bicycle pump (High Street)

- a **RESOLVED** to provide delegated authority to the Governance & Operations Manager to organise both the removal of the damaged High Street bicycle pump and making good of the pavement at a maximum cost of £150+VAT. It was noted that an assessment of whether the bicycle pump was repairable would be carried out once it had been removed.
- b **RESOLVED** that the contractor appointed for the recent Parkgate bicycle pump removal/installation be appointed to remove the High Street bicycle pump to ensure a consistent standard.
