21 Apologies for absence

There were no apologies for absence.

22 Declarations of Interest

Cllr Kynaston declared a non-pecuniary interest in agenda item 27.

23 Christmas lights switch-on event

- a The Committee received an oral report from the Grants Task & Finish Group.
- b **RESOLVED** to make a request to a local community group to facilitate a Christmas lights switch-on event on either 29th or 30th November.
- c **RESOLVED** to set a budget of £7,000 (line 4360 – grants & donations) as a one-off payment to cover all costs including road closures, licences and any other costs.
- d The Committee agreed that an offer of £7,000 should be made to Hip & Harmony in the first instance with an explanation of the funding criteria and that the Chair and Cllr Griffiths would meet with Hip & Harmony to discuss further.

24 Christmas Decorations – High Street

- a The Committee considered report PE3/24 regarding CWaC's request for the Town Council to take responsibility for the High Street lights and Christmas tree.
- b The Committee decided to inform CWaC that the Town Council would work towards formalising an agreement for Christmas 2020.

25 Neston High School Wellness Fair

- a The Committee agreed that the Town Council should have a stall at the "Ways to Wellbeing" Fair to be held at Neston High School on Saturday 12 October.
- b Cllrs Kynaston, Griffiths & Wastell volunteered to man the stall and it was agreed that the only resources needed would be the Town Council's podium exhibition stand.

26 2019/20 Junior Mayor/Deputies – purchase of medals/badges

RESOLVED to purchase medals/badges at a maximum cost of £60.00+VAT and delivery from budget line 4371 (youth engagement).

27 Neston Music Festival 2020

RESOLVED to earmark £1000 from budget line 4360 (grants & donations) to be used for publicity materials for the Neston Music Festival 2020.
