Subject: Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) payment to Neston Town Council

Good afternoon Zoe/Trevor,

I have previously contacted you regarding the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL). Further monies are due to Neston Town Council. The amount being paid is £4,531.62 and you should receive this amount soon, but please let me know if this has not been received by 4th April 2025.

To remind you again, broadly speaking, the neighbourhood portion of CIL can be spent on:

- a. the provision, improvement, replacement, operation, or maintenance of infrastructure; or
- b. anything else that is concerned with addressing the demands that development places on an area.

Infrastructure is defined as:

Social infrastructure: e.g. art and culture, sports halls, education, health, social care, emergency services, community centres, village halls

Physical infrastructure: e.g. pavements, cycleways, flood defences, highways, transport links

Green infrastructure: e.g. play areas, public open space, woodlands
