## **Sub-group Updates**

### **Children and Young People**

ADHD training for the Social Prescriber will be done in June in order to be able to run an eight-week course for adults affected by ADHD in various ways in the community.

Wirral are training GPs with similar training.

Attendance numbers are dwindling on Young People and Mental Health. Looking to organise an event to raise awareness, a Wellbeing Fair.

The Big Lunch for the community will be on 8<sup>th</sup> June.

### **Older People**

Very short of volunteers. Having a stall in the market on 6<sup>th</sup> June to try and get new volunteers.

More drivers are needed for Community Transport.

### **Border Issues**

Looking to get funding for the NCYC Hospital Discharge service as the current funding runs out in October.

### **Refugees and Asylum Seekers**

Leanne introduced herself as the CWaC Move on Support Officer for refugees and asylum seekers and gave an update on the current situation in our area. They are going to be providing drop-in centres at the Neston Foodbank, Trinity Church in Ellesmere Port and the Salvation Army in Winsford.

BRIO are providing free gym membership funded from Sanctuary Funding.

NCYC are applying for Sanctuary Funding to run an advice service in Neston Library.
