		Bunting Provision	FC3/43a

Background

At the Community & Environment Committee meeting on 11 August 2026, residents spoke in favour of the Town Council continuing to install bunting in the town centre throughout the summer period, citing its historical significance and its importance in creating a distinct market town identity.

For Discussion and Decision

- a) Full Council to decide whether to install bunting in Neston Town Centre between June and August 2027.
- b) Full Council to agree an environmental statement in relation to the sourcing and disposal of bunting:

Neston Town Council aims to avoid environmental damage and will endeavour to minimise the impact of plastic bunting by avoiding the use of any flexible PVC. Whilst the Town Council acknowledges that alternatives such polyester are still made from non-biodegradable plastic and have an inherently negative environmental impact, the least damaging option will be sourced and Neston Town Council commits to financing environmentally responsible disposal of the material when it is no longer usable.
